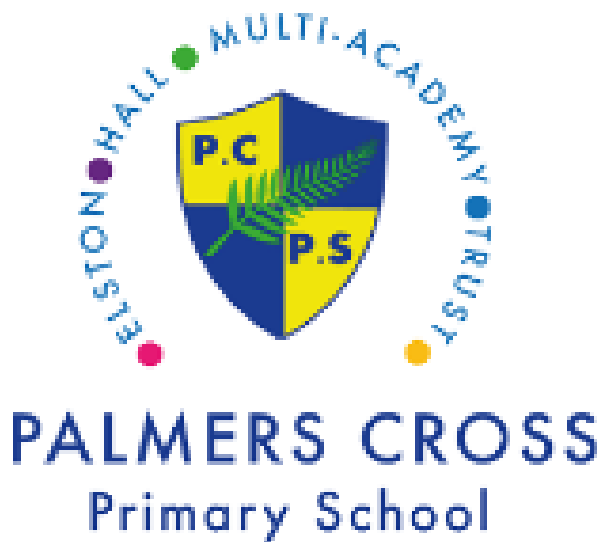

# What we are doing to help your child

- Throughout the year we join year 1 to participate in events
- Transition meeting with parents
- Teaching in the year 1 classroom with familiar adults
- Begin whole class teaching
- Starting to join KS1 at break times
- Planned new teacher working with them discreetly
- Staff transition meetings to share information

**A letter is enclosed with your child's school report to inform you child and your child who the year one teacher will be.**

# How you can help your child

- Continue to encourage their independence. In year 1 they will need to be responsible for returning their own reading books, homework and letters etc.
- If you wish to, you can start waiting at the Early Years gate and watching your child walk down to the Reception entrance by themselves in preparation for their entry via the main playground gates in September
- Read at home regularly with your child
