



Year 6 Summer Term



Welcome back after the Easter break. This term we will continue with our exciting thematic curriculum – ‘Global Warning’. We will also become entrepreneurs to make and sell products to raise funds for our fun day.

Maths

Within Maths, we will be completing lots of practice papers and revising test techniques in the run-up to SATs. The children will then complete mathematical challenges, as well as an enterprise project, to show how the skills they have learned can be applied in the real world.

English

English learning will have a strong focus on the required standard at the end of Year 6 – children will continue to write sentences with ambitious vocabulary and punctuation, whilst manipulating sentences for effect. Children will be encouraged to use a variety of higher-level punctuation, in order to make sentences more varied and interesting for the reader. They will be writing at length this term, in order to provide more detailed pieces of writing that culminates the skills they have learnt and are demonstrated within their writing. Learning will be based around a variety of genres and stimuli including narratives, letters and diaries.

Reading

The children will be building on their comprehension skills, focusing on the main question types in preparation for their SATs paper. They will be completing a mixture of comprehension questions and SATs style questions.

Science

In science, we will focus on evolution and inheritance, learning about fossils and how natural selection occurs.

Religious Education

The children will be looking at values and what matters most to the children and the wider community.

Topic

“Global Warning” is a thematic unit, which is geography-focused with sustainability and eco literacy at its heart. This project-based theme involves pupils applying their learning about the global environmental issues of waste and pollution by creating a board game, which is both educational and fun. The pupils will work in groups to research, design and produce their board game, after which they will present and demonstrate it to the class. After this, the children will complete two more units – Pharaoh Queen and I have a Dream.

P.E

Year 6 PE sessions will continue to be on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Please ensure your child has a full PE kit and all clothing is clearly labelled.

MFL

Modern Foreign Languages will focus on French. Children will continue to build upon conversational French as well as beginning to describe family members and hobbies.

PSHEe

Children will have plenty of time in PSHE to have sessions based around transition to high school. Firstly, we will focus on physical health and mental wellbeing, growing and changing including human reproduction and birth before finishing in summer 2 with Keeping safe including, keeping personal information safe; regulations and choices; drug use and the law and drug use and the media.
