Alongside this, we will be focusing on practising for the times table check, that will take place in June. Children will be exposed to all times tables (2-12) and become more confident when recalling the answers.

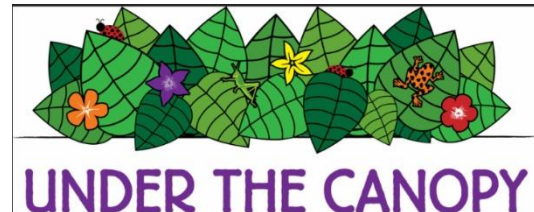
