During the summer term, we will be enjoying our final term of learning for this year and preparing to say goodbye to some of our friends who will be moving on to new schools at the end of the year.

Maths

In maths this term, children will continue to follow the Maths Mastery approach to help build a solid foundation of their mathematical understanding. Each week they will also continue to have an arithmetic lesson where children will focus their learning on the four operations: addition, subtraction, division and multiplication.

English

In English will continue to focus on applying the children will continue to apply their phonetic knowledge to spell new and unfamiliar words. Where children can, they will then continue to develop their sentence writing skills with independence using colour semantics to help them.

Science

Over the year, the children will continue to study the weather - how it affects our environment and how the seasons change. Our science focus for this term will begin with finalising our forces and magnets. We will then move on to look at plants and animals. If we have time, we may also look at light during the final weeks of term.

Topic

To start the summer term our topic will be 'Under the Sea'. After half term our new topic will be 'A Ticket to Ride'
