We will use this as a basis for planning the different areas of the curriculum where possible.</p> <p>Our learning takes place though a variety of lessons including investigations, exploration, computing, and music. We will also provide the children a variety of sensory opportunities.</p>	<p>Communication and language This term we will continue to develop our communication skills through activities that develop our vocabulary, our sentences, communicating in a variety of ways. <p>Personal, Social and Emotional Development Through all areas of the curriculum, children will develop their skills surrounding making relationships, self-confidence and awareness and managing their feelings and behaviour.</p>	<p>Cognition and learning Within these lessons we will develop the children's maths skills and other aspects of the curriculum. We will introduce them to activities that involve counting, patterns, money, time and other areas.</p>
<p>Sensory The children have daily sensory play and breaks which gives them time to self-regulate whilst allowing them the opportunity to explore different sensory activities.</p>	
<p>Physical development Children receive 1 taught PE lessons each week on a Thursday but have daily access to our outdoor classroom, allowing their gross motor skills to be refined. The children will also improve their fine motor skills by taking part in daily fine motor activities such as cutting and threading. The children have daily opportunities to make marks and create large marks to develop motor skills further. The children will also have access to outdoor learning activities. They children have daily sensory circuits/ cool kids sessions.</p>	<p>Stories The children have weekly stories which we retell in a sensory way. The stories are usually related to topic and give the children the opportunity to engage practically in stories.</p>
