## Oxford Reading Tree Floppy's Phonics programme

**Our Floppy's Phonics meeting is designed:** 

- to inform parents and carers about how phonics is taught in school
- to help us to work in partnership to support children with their early reading

What is phonics? **Recognising the sounds made by a letter/s** in a word. Synthetic phonics is sounding out and blending the sounds to read the unknown words



#### Terminology

Phoneme – smallest unit of sound in a word (this could a single letter or group of letters)

Grapheme – The written representation of a sound/phoneme

Digraph – 2 letters representing the same sound e.g. oi er

Trigraph – 3 letters representing the same sound e.g. igh ear

Blend – to say the sounds together to read a word

Buttons and bars- the way in which children record how they have decoded a word

Helpful words- words learnt by sight, introduced steadily through programme e.g. the go to







Alphabetic Code Chart

Picture-words and their printed words make the learning of the different sounds and spellings more memorable and manageable and can clarify the teaching and learning for adults and children alike.



When letters and sounds are introduced, the books are numbered. Year 1 starts at level 4 – book 19.


